SCORING: Scholarships are awarded based

on:

ACT/SAT Score 20%

GPA & Class Rank 25%

Student Activities 20%

Financial Need 20%

Personal Statement 15%

HOW TO APPLY: The application form will be available at www.lumbeeriver.com or from high school guidance counselors, starting each January.

DEADLINE: Lumbee River EMC accepts scholarship applications beginning on the first business day of each year. Applications and supporting documentation must be received by close of business on the first Friday of the month of March to be considered for scholarship funding.

The scholarship must be used for educational costs, and the student must enter college in the fall of the school year for which the scholarship is given. Checks will be made payable to the school by Lumbee River EMC.
